

# Candidate Mobility Solutions Steering Committee Preliminary Evaluations

The candidate mobility solutions were presented to the Steering Committee at the March 3, 2009 meeting and the question was asked, “Do you think this solution will help accomplish the Goals and Objectives?” Steering Committee members rated each candidate solution using hand-held keypads with the automated polling system. Ratings ranged from “1” (Least Effective) to “9” (Most Effective). A summary graph is provided below which shows the mean (average) score for each solution along with its standard deviation (denoted as “SD”). The standard deviation is a statistical measure that describes the “spread” or range of results. A lower standard deviation reflects a consistency of individual scores about the average while a higher standard deviation indicates a wider range of individual scores. Detailed scoring for each candidate solution is included in the accompanying PowerPoint presentation. It should be noted that the ratings are totally subjective as this stage and do not reflect any technical evaluation of individual solutions.
